We are incredibly proud of our little Montessoriens who got a good grip of the golf club on their first session and we are super excited to be enjoying this fun and enriching moment with them.

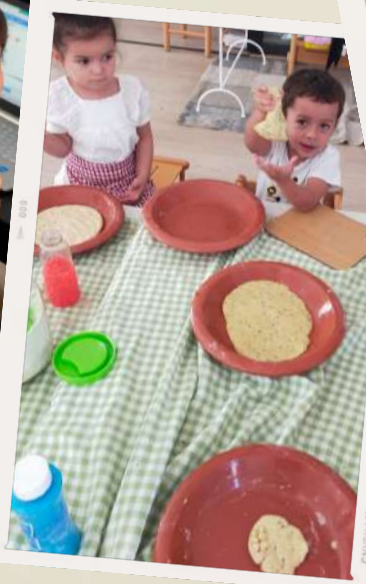


LEARN NEW SKILLS !

Our adolescents learn to be creative, problem solvers by working in an environment that encourages experiments, multiple solutions, acceptance of errors as a normal part of the learning process. For the second unit, guides gave key lessons and opportunities for the adolescents to think outside the box and use their imagination and creativity. The adolescents chose their own topic, worked on it for 6 weeks and presented their output in front of other students and teachers.
