












Our School Vision and Mission

It brings together classroom (or after school) study into a global problem-solving journey for upper elementary and middle school students. Each student becomes a delegate of a selected nation. Student delegates write, present and debate issues affecting their nations and peoples of the world.

By assuming the role of delegates, they develop an under- standing of the needs of diverse people and the importance of multilateralism. Working through the complexities of world problems, they see the interdependence of nations and the importance of global goals that leave no one behind.



Adolescents applied for positions in Production and Exchange, Communication and Marketing, Farm, Animals, Economy and Housekeeping. They submitted application letters and resumes to see if they qualify for the position. An interview was also conducted to finalise the hiring process.

A great way for our students to learn how to answer difficult questions, improve their communication skills and reduce stress.

Economic and Social independence are very important tendencies and sensitivities of the 3rd plane of adolescent development. Production and Exchange is part of the Erdkinder curriculum because it gives the adolescents the opportunity to practice a more sophisticated level of decision-making.

Production and exchange becomes a direct connection of the environment with the outside world. The farm also teaches the interrelationship of things and a myriad of other concepts that are related to production.

It is a real experience for the application of everyday basic math skills and mental math. It gives an understanding of skills such as creating a budget, managing income and expenses and living within one's means.



ESL PROGRAM



At Planete Montessori International School, English is our primary language of communication and instruction, therefore it is very important for us that the learners, and especially elementary children are well prepared. We are committed to providing a high standard of communicating, teaching and learning in English.

During our enrollment process, our English guides proceeded to an assessment that covered severals aspects (comprehension, reading and writing,) and allowed the learners to demonstrate their abilities and knowledges.

For the children who needed it, our school provided a 6 weeks intensive ESL program from the beginning of the year in order to assist them with learning and developing language skills in English.

The children were able to develop the six basic skills of the English Language, Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking, Grammar and Vocabulary with our two fantastic ESL teachers: Ms Farah & Ms Janine!

November will mark the end of the ESL 6 Weeks Program. However, our ESL Teachers will continue to assist all children with learning and developing skills in English. They will be present in all our 6 to 12 yo environments throughout the week to work in one to one or in group.

ABOUT ME :



I am 26 years old, and have been in the field of education since 2016, working as a Student-teaching mentor and ILS adviser for over six years. I also diligently worked as an English and ESL teacher for learners and non-native speakers. I currently have a total of 36 units in my ongoing pursuit of my Masters degree in Education.

I have an ardent love for children, as I believe that there is a certain magic that comes with shaping and developing young minds. I maintain a firm belief in the capacity of each child to blossom and flourish in their own unique way, and I wish to aid them in realizing their full potentials.

WHAT I HAVE BEEN WORKING ON WITH THE CHILDREN:

I have been handling these bright and sharp-witted students for over 6 weeks now. The lessons we have had so far during our classes include a mixture of reading proper pronunciation, phonogram, writing, communication skills, CVCs, and sight word mastery, the level of their lesson varies depending on each student's capability, therefore ensuring that each student has something to take away every time the class ends. ABOUT ME :

I am 25 years old and I am the 9-12 environment ESL teacher.

I studied English and business Administration and got my MBA degree in Turkey. I have 5 years experience in teaching English Language to kids and adults of different levels. I am a Celta holder certified from Cambridge University in London. I am looking forward to sharing all what I have learnt throughout the years with all the students, and I am thrilled to join Planete Montessori International school and be a part of this great team.

WHAT I HAVE BEEN WORKING ON WITH THE CHILDREN:

During these six weeks of intensive ESL courses students have generally focused on vocabulary and how to express oneself by using simple sentences.

We worked on pronunciation and phonetics, vowels and consonants sounds as well as vocabulary related to the school such as school subjects, objects and environments components.

Reading was the skill to focus on, students had about 30 mins a day reading a book or an article and answering comprehension questions. In addition to vocabulary related to the community, places and occupations. We worked on improving the writing skills, we practiced writing common words as well as sentences, proper and common nouns, plural and singular and the difference between feminine and masculine.

During the last weeks, we focused on both grammar and vocabulary and have studied different types of foods and drinks as well as introducing the verb to be in the present.

This week will be a revision of all that was taught, with more attention given to reading and pronunciation. As the students are now ready to join their classes, I'll be assisting them in their environment in order to better improve their English.





LEARNING NEW SKILLS!


October marks the beginning of our extra curriculum activities program. The perfect opportunity for our learners to develop new skills while having a lot of fun.










Three Way Meeting

At Planete Montessori International School, we are proud to provide 2 toddlers communities. We welcome children 12 months and older, as long as they walk steadily. In order to respect the child's need for repetition and order, our school operates exclusively on full days, from Monday to Friday. Our young children learn how to take care of themselves, their environment and each other. We focus heavily on using social context to develop independence through language and movement.

Computer Science & Digital Literacy LEARN TO CODE!

As you know, Digital Education is now part of the curriculum of our 9 to 12 yo learners! Children started to work on a specific curriculum and will be covering different themes throughout the year. This program will help our children to develop problem solving skills such as perseverance, trial and error as well as the understanding of the cause and effect. They will be using analytical thinking, reasoning skills and literacy skills and be encouraged to think creatively and to pursue innovative solutions.

WHAT IS IT?

Our teachers are working on a pedagogical approach making it possible for the children to popularize complex notions related to digital education and understand the logic behind the concepts rather than a crude presentation to them.

It's as much about learning programming as it is about developing creativity, logic and collaboration through "unplugged" activities but also about challenging misconceptions, deconstructing fantasies involving technology and being able to navigate in the digital world with ease and is safety.

Students will have the opportunity to work on project based learning so they can apply and consolidate their knowledge and understanding.
